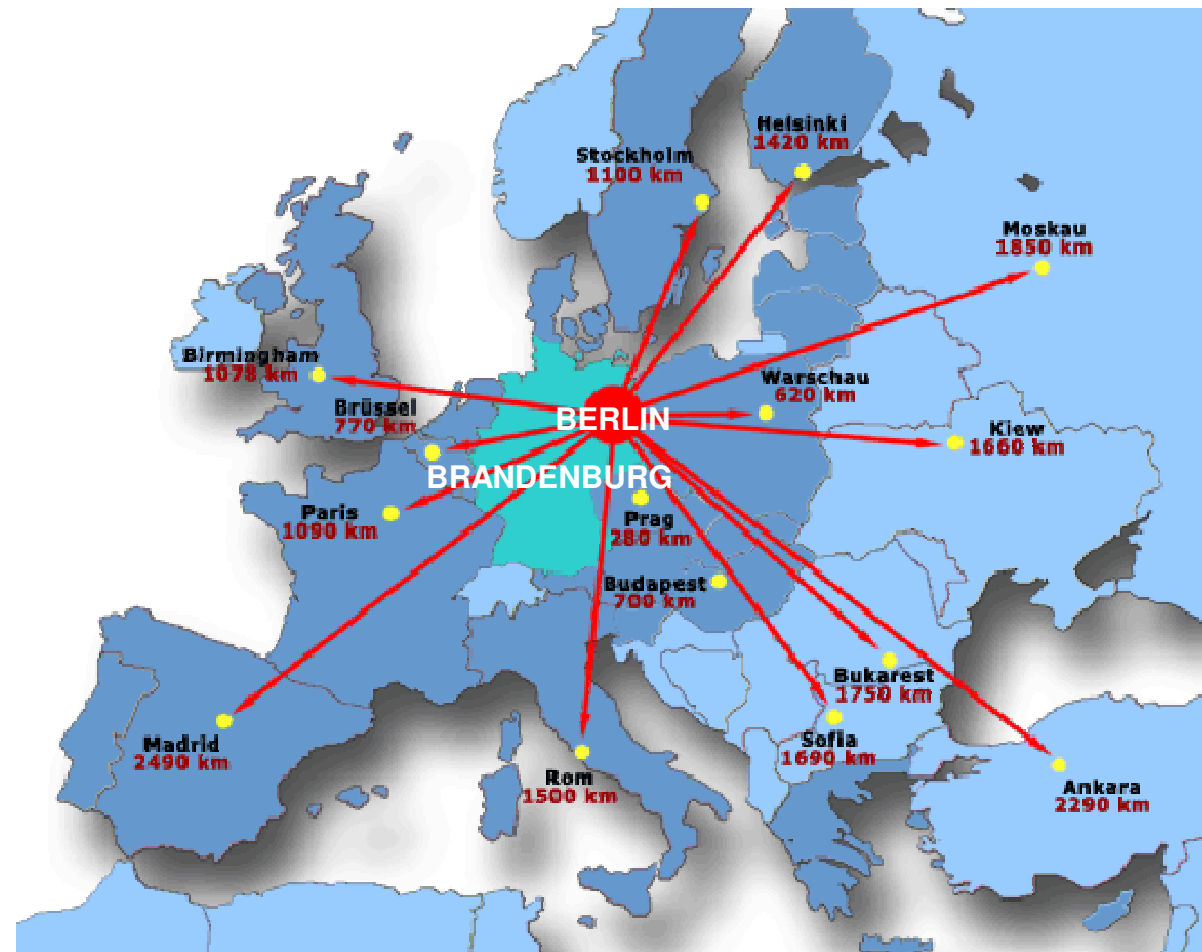

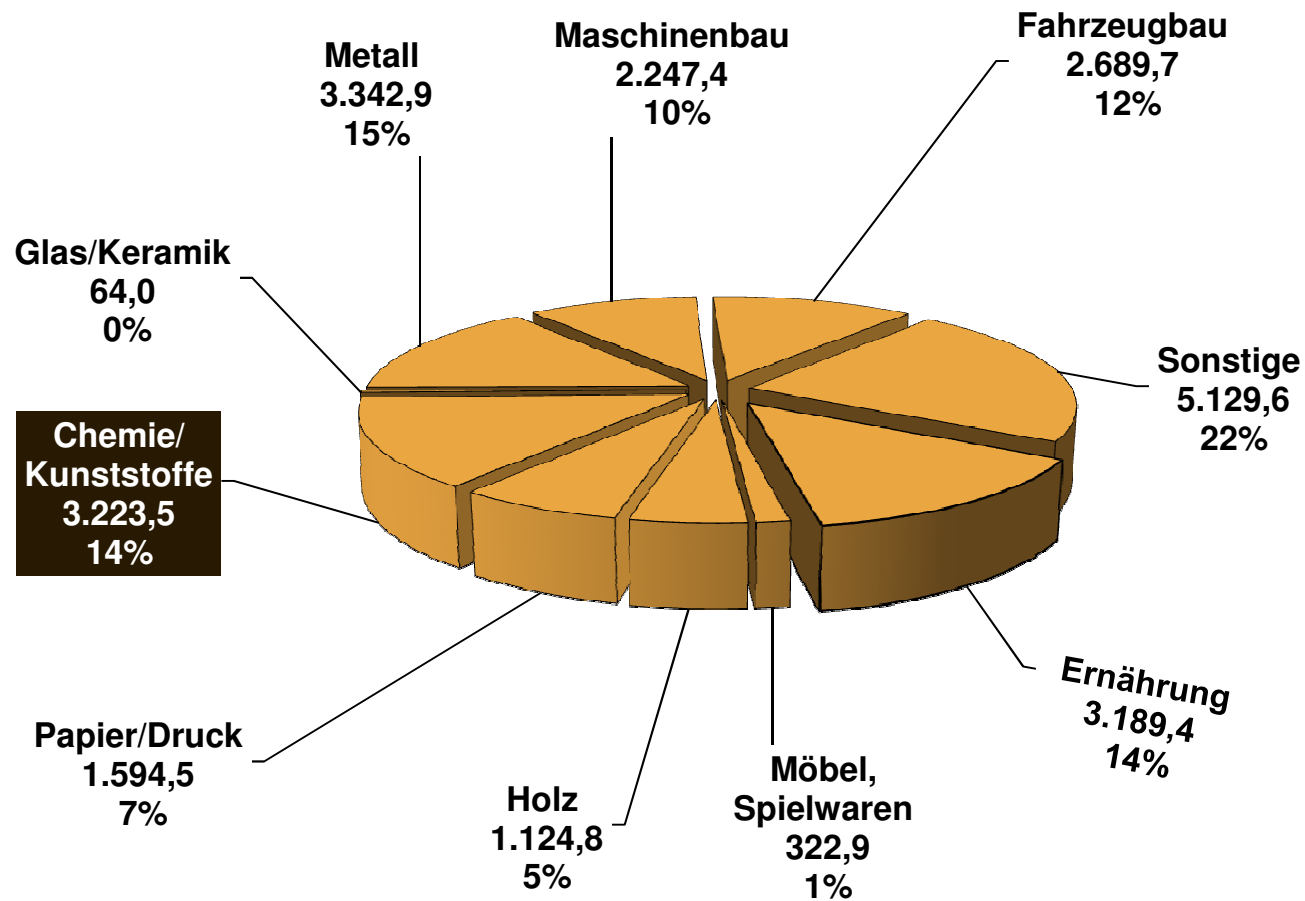

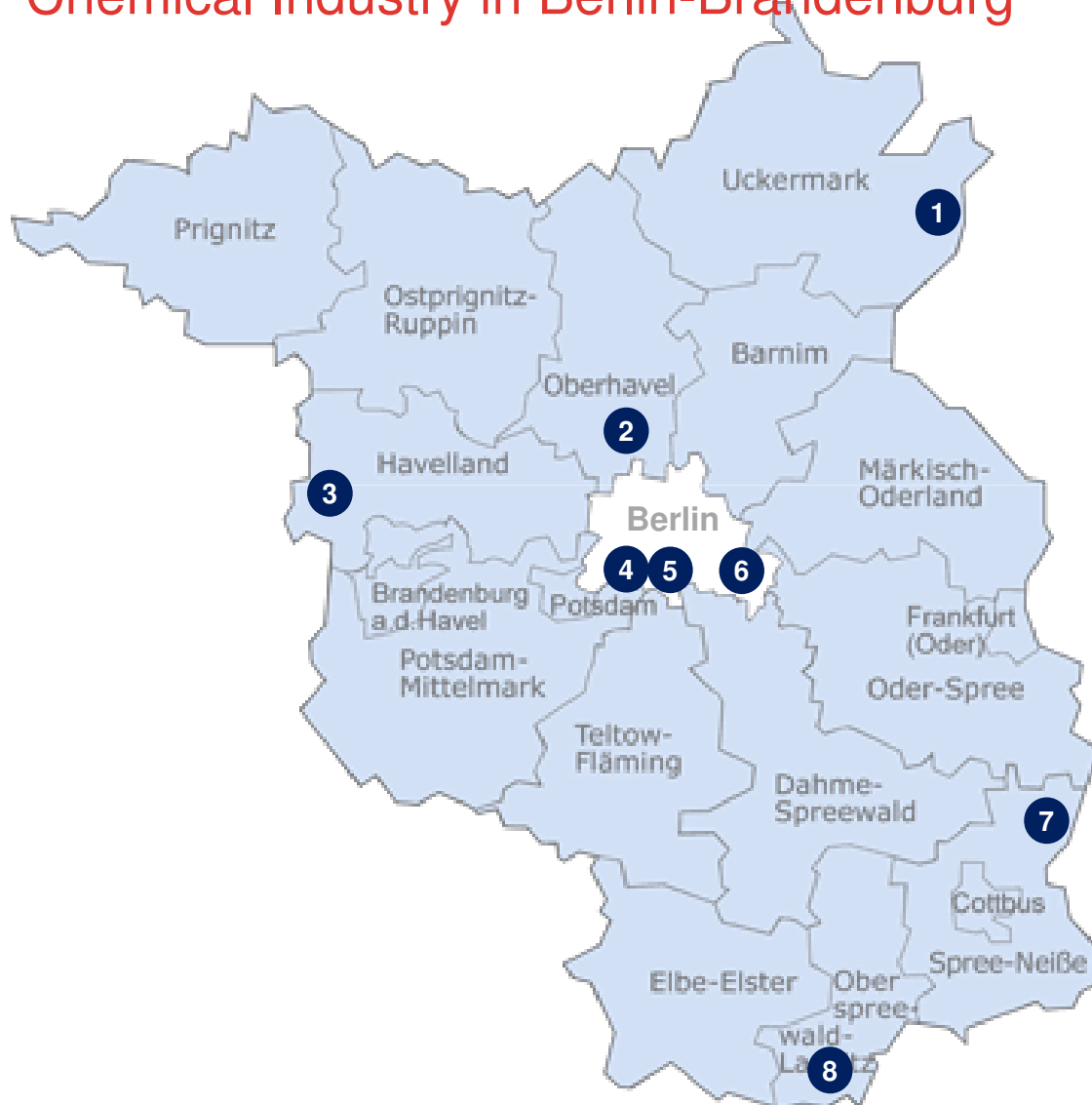


Branches in the commercial economy in 2008 in Brandenburg

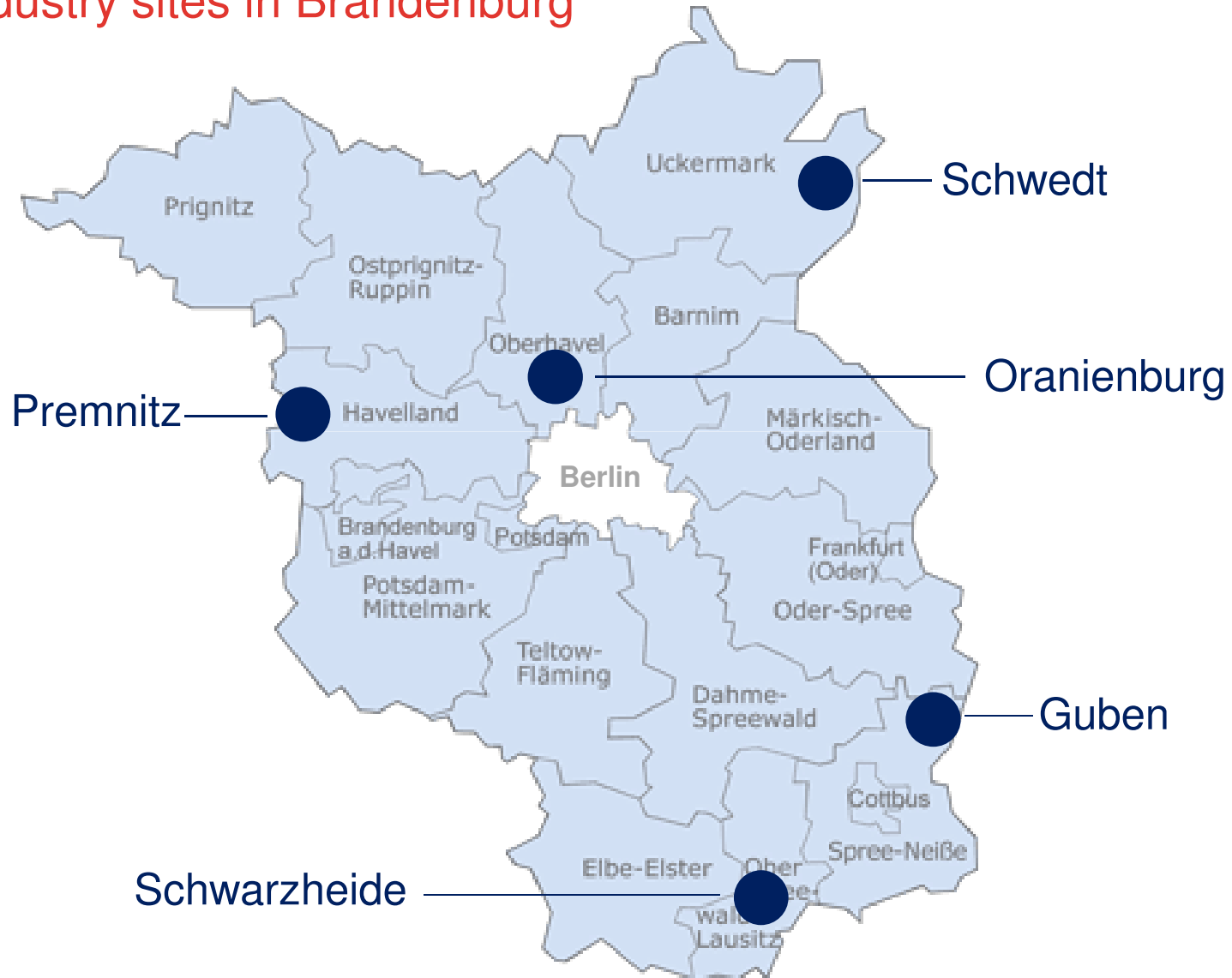

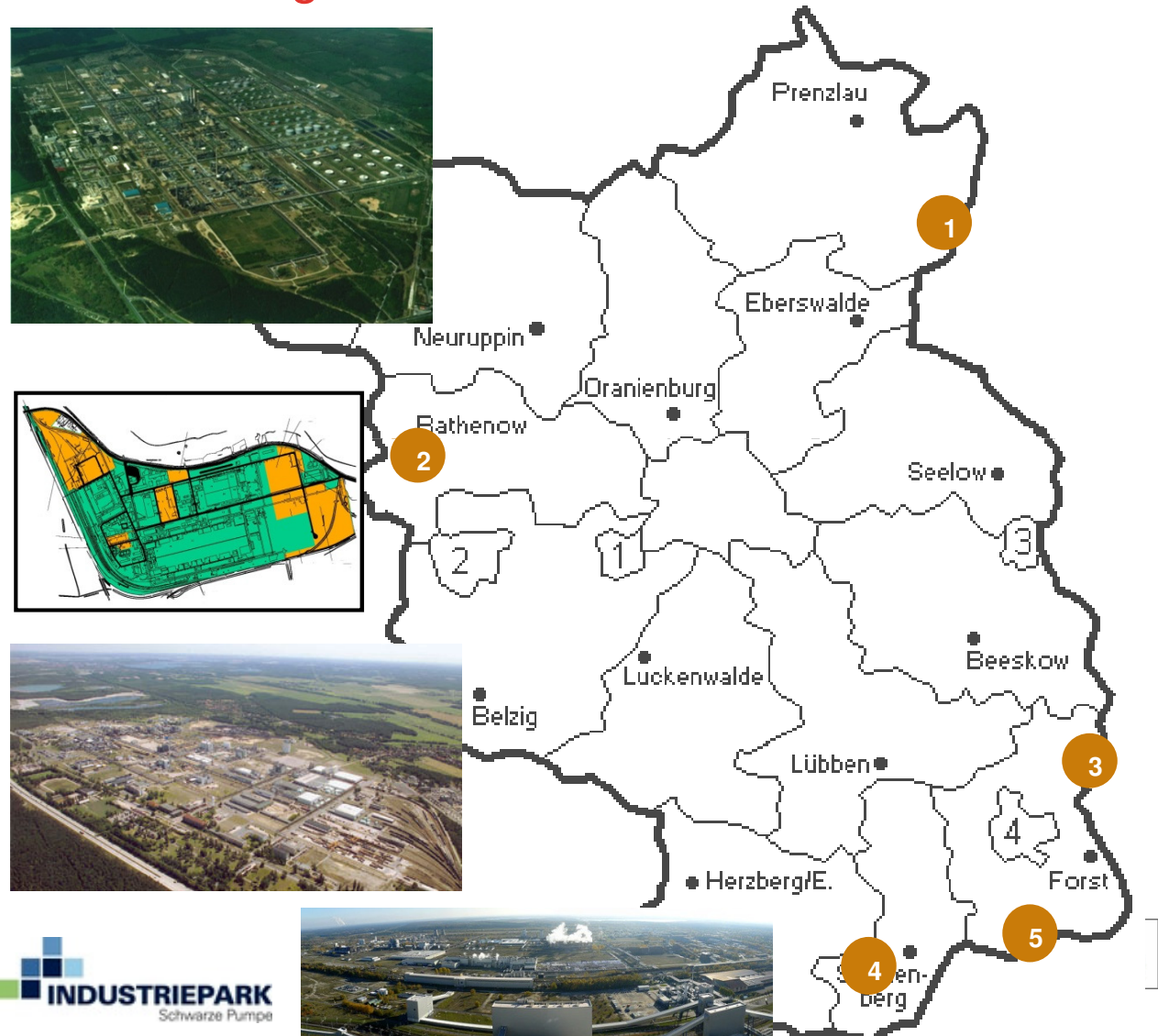

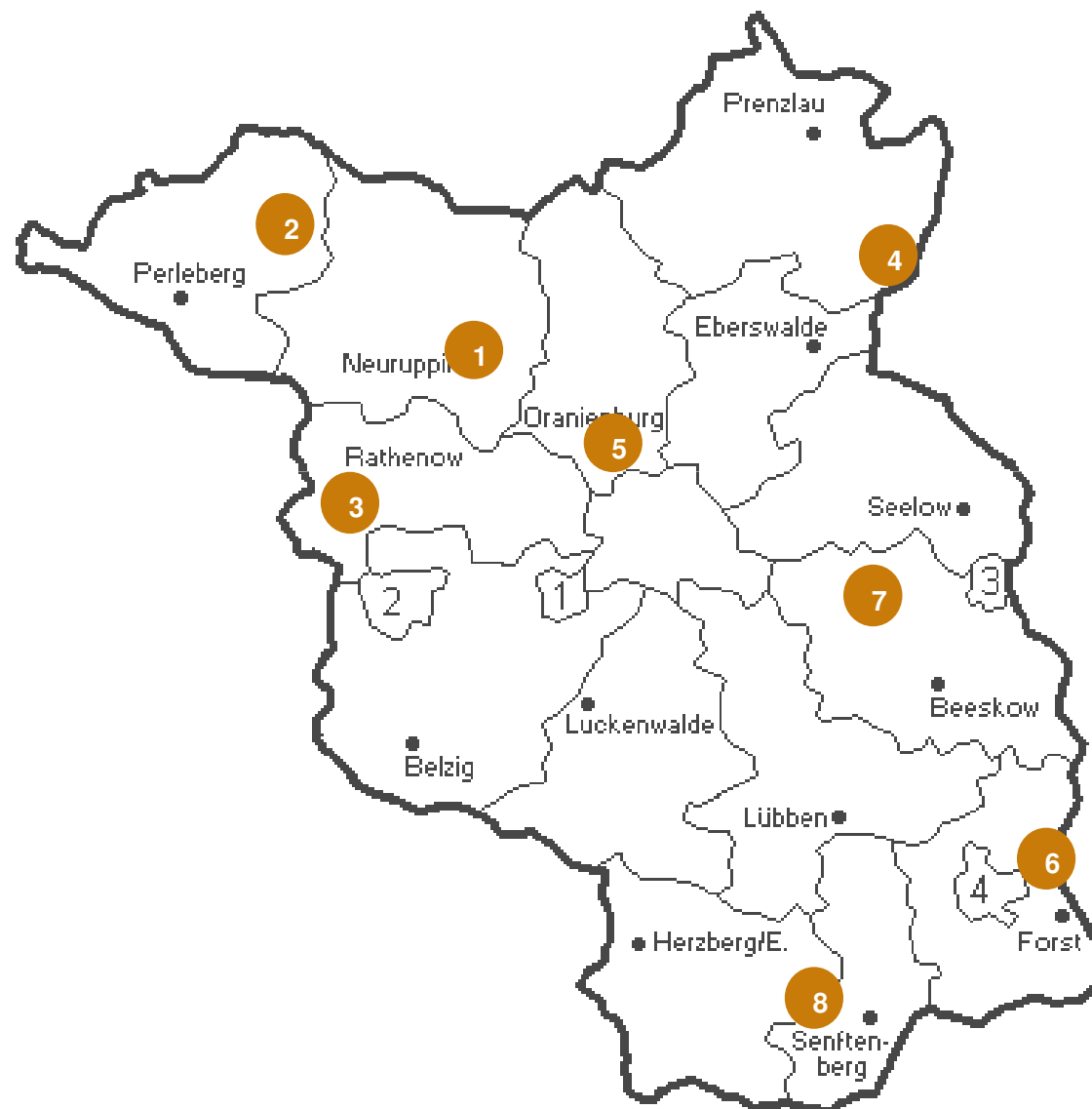
