How to reach us:

From Brussels Airport:

You can take the *shuttle train* to Bruxelles City Centre and get off at "Gare Centrale" (railway-station "Centrale"). Then:

- Metro 1A direction "Herrmann-Debroux" get off at "Thieffry"
- Take Rue de l'Escadron until you reach the crossing with Blvd. St. Michel (5 min. walk)
- Number 80 is nearly exactly in the front of you on the other side of the road

You can also take a *taxi* (approx. 30 Euros)

- Metro 2 direction "Simonis", change at "Arts-Loi" to
- Metro 1A direction "Herrmann-Debroux" get off at "Thieffry"
