

Target: Investment protocol


An **agreement** of involved parties on a list of projects and a commitment to:

- preparing individual bankable business plans for the foreseen investments
- finding resources to co-finance the investments envisaged in the protocol





Developing Investment Protocols building on four types of investment projects







Examples of Investment Types

■ New production lines

Develop new production procedures to improve efficiency and profitability

Shared training facilities

Work together to develop a shared facility and content for training entrepreneurs or researchers

■ Common capacity building

Equip businesses and entrepreneurs with the skills to develop, manage, implement and evaluate solutions to societal challenges


Shared technology centres

Launch a technology centre with public and private organisations to undertake product research and innovation

■ Research and development (R&D) cooperation

Build cooperation in R&D as a platform for improved policy coordination, new networking activities and for sharing knowledge and innovation








Towards a Thematic Smart specialisation partnership roadmap

Core issues:

- What can the partnership achieve working inter-regionally that is additional and complementary to what is being done through regional S3 or chemical sector strategies?
- What existing initiatives/research & innovation infrastructures exist and how can they be leveraged to support the partnership's objectives
- Which regions have 'leading-edge expertise' or advanced facilities that qualify them to take a **lead on joint actions**.
- How to develop long-term co-operation and an investment pipeline and not just 'hunt EU project funding'.





Tentative timeline for partnership development and implementation

Mapping

- Identify business needs (survey ?)
- Mapping of regional expertise and infrastructures
- Agree on common priorities.
- Agree on roadmap of actions for 2019

Matching

- Working groups on key technologies or priority challenges
- Business match-making events
- Identify additional expertise require

Design and test

- Feasibility studies / codevelopment of pilot actions
- Develop business case/plan for possible coinvestment
- Design an inter-regional network of open access R&I facilities

Scale up / invest

- Co-investment in joint demonstration and industrial project
- Secure


